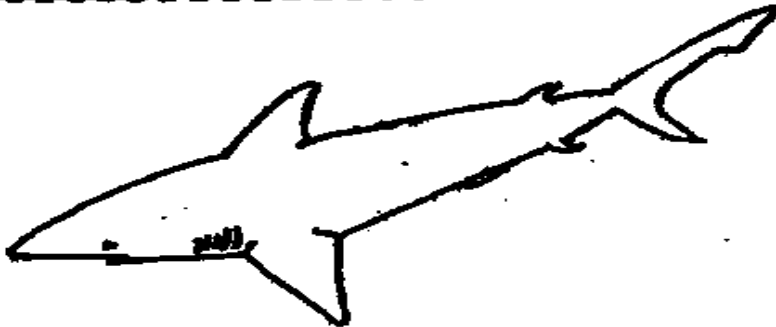


Memory Game

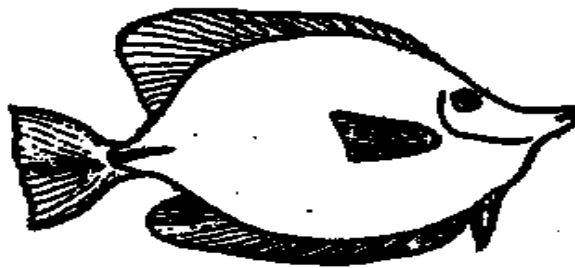
Photocopy two sets of the marine animals. Paste these sheets to a card and color them before cutting them out. Then, use the cards as pairs for a memory game.

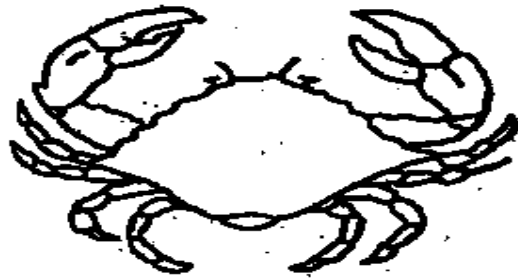

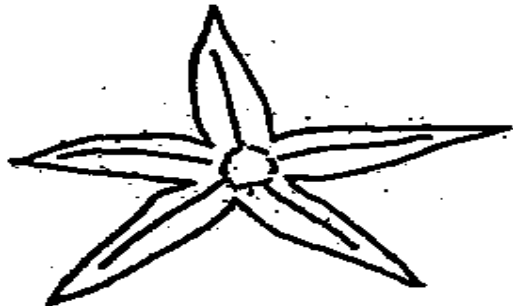
