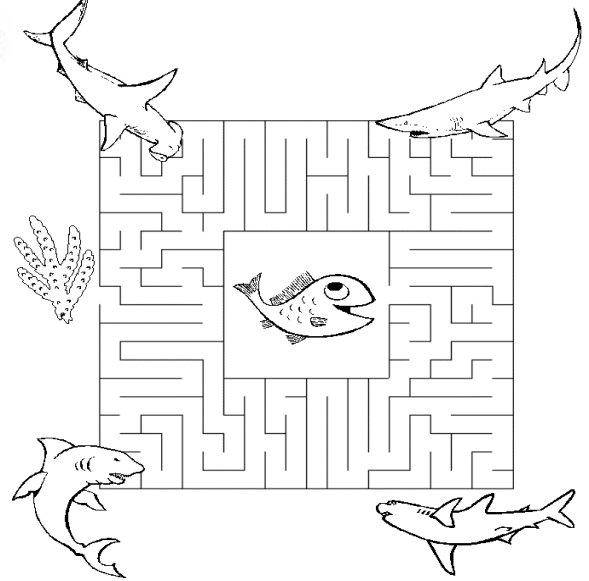

Amazing Shark Facts

- **Sharks can have up to 300 teeth at any one time.**
- **The biggest shark (and fish) living is the Whale Shark. It can grow to be 50 feet (15 meters) long and weigh 15 tons!**
- **A shark can live for weeks without a meal because its liver has stored fat in it.**
- **Shark skeletons are made of cartilage (Like the soft bone in your nose and ears).**
- **Sharks have been on the earth for approximately 350 million years!**
- **Sharks don't have scales like other fish—they have dermal denticles, which feel just like sandpaper.**
- **Sharks do not chew their food they swallow it whole!**
