



## **Payment**

A deposit has to be made in order to confirm your sleepover. The remainder of your payment is due when you arrive for your sleepover. **There is no refund on if you cancel in less than 72 hours of your sleepover dates** and times listed above.

## **Chaperones**

In accordance with the Department of Education and the County of Maui, Maui Ocean Center's policy for chaperoning school children is as follows:

- The chaperones are responsible for and are required to supervise the students at all times while on Maui Ocean Center property.
- Chaperones are responsible for advising students of appropriate behavior and for ensuring that they are respectful of all staff members and each other at all times.
- Should a child become disorderly, sick, or otherwise uncomfortable about being away from home, the chaperones are responsible for calling the parents for a pick up.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Where and when do I drop-off and pick-up my group?**

You will drop-off and pick-up your group at the Maui Ocean Center **BACK service area gate (near the admin office) - NOT the front gate.**

You will drop-off your group at **5:30pm** and pick-up your group at **8:00am.**

### **What food is included?**

Dinner: Pizza and juice

Snacks: Popcorn and juice; animal crackers

Breakfast: Continental breakfast, fruit, Orange Juice and Milk

### **Can I bring my own food?**

You may bring your own food and we do have a refrigerator and microwave that can be made available for exceptions such as those who are having a b-day party and want to store the cake or those with food allergies etc.

### **Can I modify the activities to suit my group needs?**

Yes! Upon booking your sleepover program, just ask the Education Manager what other activities might be available or you can make a special request. We are able to accommodate most any marine related topics and activities that may be of interest to your particular group.

### **What is the appropriate age group for a sleepover?**



3rd-8th grade is the most effective age for this program. We also can accommodate adult groups as well.

### **What if my child goes home sick and is unable to stay the night?**

As long as your child does not get sent home for misbehaving, they are able to get a credit and join in the next sleepover. Unfortunately we are not able to give refunds unless there is a 72 hr. cancellation notice.

6:20 Overview for the night/introductions

7:30 Activity 1 (rotate to each station)

8:15 Activity 2

9:30 Movie & Popcorn in Movie Room, free time- games and snacks

10:30 LIGHTS OUT

Next Morning. . .

6:00 Wake up and observe the beautiful Open Ocean Exhibit/ Bathrooms

6:30 Clean-up/put sleeping bags and personal items all together outside

7:00 Continental breakfast with fruit, OJ, and Milk

7:30 Review and wrap up activities

8:00am Depart Maui Ocean Center

### **What should I bring?**
