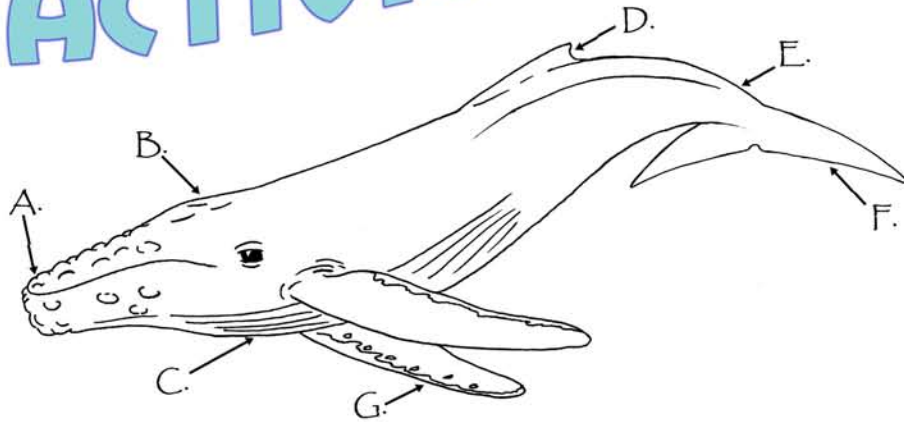

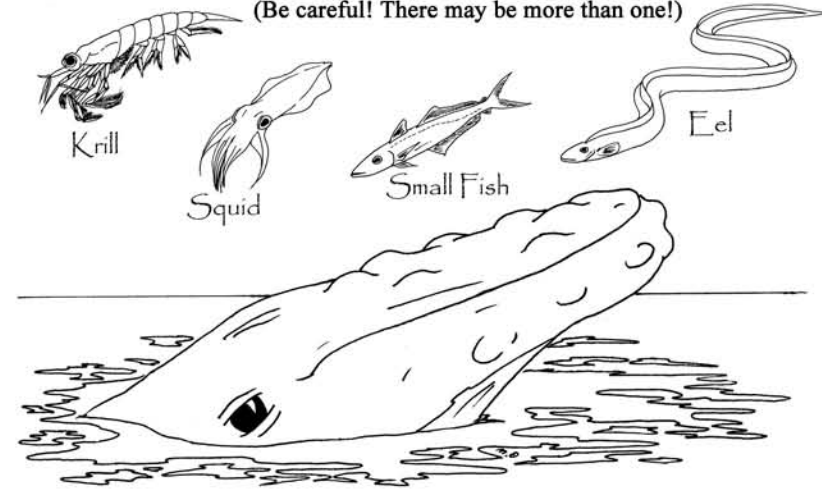
## Lunch Time!

(Be careful! There may be more than one!)

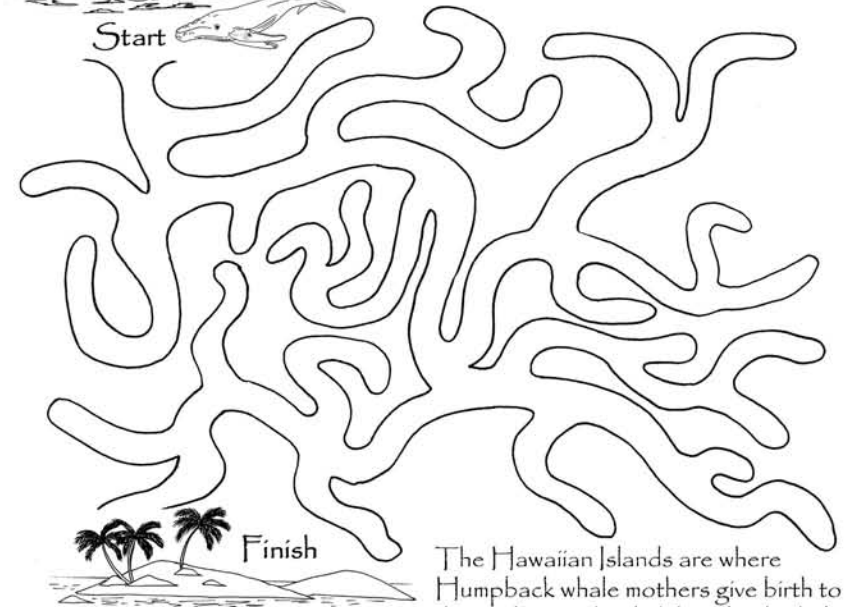
- Fluke
